### USE INSTRUCTIONS

## Preparation Before Use

Wash thoroughly with dish soap and a soft sponge.

Use Guide



Place your thumb on the circle indent located on the slide-lock disc. Push your thumb forward to open the slide-lock disc to reveal the sip hole.



Microwave

To close the slide-lock disc, use a finger to push the back edge into place until you hear a click. The click indicates a secure, leak-proof closure.

Please pay attention when setting down. The Carter body is sturdy stainless steel but will dent if dropped on hard surfaces. Carter is not microwave safe.

Do not use any metal stirring utensils in Carter. This will scratch the ceramic non-stick coating. Do not let children use.

### CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Please hand wash Carter. Dishwashing the product-even on the top rack-may result in discoloration of the coating.

For hand washing, use only liquid dish soap. Do not use chlorine, bleach, or other chemicals to clean. Let air or towel dry thoroughly.

Using a coarse sponge, brush, or other rough surface will scratch the outer and interior suraces of Carter. Use only a soft sponge. While not in use, store Carter with the lid off to prevent unwanted smells.

Once a week, disassemble the slide-lock lid completely to hand wash each part thoroughly.
